# View from the Chair

2021 was a transitional year for IPSO as we began to reflect on the lessons of the Covid-19 pandemic for us as a regulator, and as an organisation, and to plan for a future in which Covid-19 - while still an important issue for the country - is no longer the dominant social and economic reality that it was at the height of the pandemic in 2020.

The press continues to play a vital role, keeping the public informed at every step of the way. The economic challenges posed and accelerated by Covid-19 and generally increasing costs are a major concern for news publishers, particularly local and regional titles. In response, IPSO has stepped up its support for local journalists with training and the creation of bespoke resources. We will continue to look for ways to protect and promote high quality local journalism in the face of economic turbulence.

Online safety has dominated much of the political discourse surrounding the press, and IPSO has

provided written evidence and advice at every stage of the deliberations, recognising both the need to improve protections for the public from online harms and the importance of ensuring that this does not come at an unacceptable cost to freedom of expression and the work of accountable publishers regulated by IPSO.

The debate surrounding press regulation has not ended. Opposition parties have not clarified their policies in this area. In the meantime, IPSO continues to provide independent regulation of a high quality. In applying the Editors' Code, we endeavour to strike a balance between the interest of those with justified complaints and the interests of a free, vigorous but accountable press. We hope this approach has the support of all political parties, and of the general public.

# Introduction from the CEO

2021 was a period of renewal for IPSO after the challenges of Covid-19. We welcomed four new board members as well as Jane Debois as a new Head of Standards and Regulation, and Robert Morrison as Head of Complaints and Pre-Publication Services.

Covid-19 remained the biggest story after dominating headlines in 2020, and a highlight of the year was the release of a first for IPSO: The Covid Report, a comprehensive review of how the press covered the Covid-19 pandemic. The report reviews a full year of the pandemic from March 2020 to April 2021 and draws upon IPSO's unique insights and datasets with case studies of contemporary rulings and impact statements from some regulated publishers.


In the period of recovery from lockdowns and other restrictions, it was more important than ever for us to maintain a programme of active engagement with members of the public, groups with an interest in editorial standards, and journalists. The Journalists' Advisory and Readers' Advisory Panels were key to

ensuring IPSO retained direct insight into the views of professionals in the industry and members of the public who stand outside it.

Privacy Notices continued to be an important tool at the public's disposal, with IPSO issuing just over one a week during 2021. We received excellent feedback from our regulated publishers and the public on their effectiveness and we will continue to offer this vital service to members of the public moving forward.

IPSO will continue to uphold editorial standards and take a leading role in policy-making surrounding online harms. As journalists and publishers change rapidly with the times, so too will IPSO adapt and consolidate its position as the UK's leading voice in press regulation and standards.

# **RESPONDING TO**

# Covid-19.

Constantly updated advice and guidance to keep the public and press informed as we moved out of the pandemic

ewspapers, magazines, and news websites played a vital role during the Covid-19 pandemic, informing the public of critical public health information and scrutinising the response to an unprecedented global crisis. It was crucial that the public was able to access trusted sources of news at this time, and the robust, independent regulation provided by IPSO promoted accountability and quality.

In 2021 IPSO supported regulated publishers to cover this unprecedented story by providing realtime guidance on emerging issues, publishing complaints case studies as they became available, and providing immediate guidance on the reporting of Covid-related issues by drawing out key learning points for editors and journalists. IPSO also protected the public by investigating complaints about editorial material and journalistic behaviour which potentially breached the Editors' Code. It also helped with concerns about possible press intrusion.



Ensuring accountability means sharing lessons, and in late 2021 IPSO published "The Covid Report", which used data, case studies and insights to look at how

the press was reporting on the pandemic.


Of the huge number of stories about Covid-19, a relatively small proportion raised potential breaches of the Code, and an even smaller proportion were upheld by IPSO's Complaints Committee. While upheld rulings identified areas for improvement, we saw clear evidence of the industry reacting swiftly to issues highlighted by IPSO and by the broader Covid-19 coverage debate. Key findings from the report included:


- Less than 10% (9.7%) of complaints received related to reporting of Covid-19 despite it dominating the news agenda.
- Of Covid-related complaints, 83% were made under Clause 1 of the Editors' Code which covers accuracy.
- IPSO opened 77 investigations into Covid-19 related complaints, resulting in 47 rulings and 38 corrections.

IPSO identified several themes in complaints received about the reporting of Covid-19:

#### **STATISTICS**

It is crucial for reporting to get numbers right in the face of rapidly changing data and information, particularly where these are used in headlines. In some cases, there is no one "right" answer; at those times, transparency is especially important. It is notable that the one front-page correction reference

#### **USE OF IMAGES**

Taking care over the accuracy of images can be nuanced but is important. Early in the pandemic, the use of images to show social distancing came under huge scrutiny. At that point publications needed to be prepared to show that they could back up the integrity of the story.

#### **COMMENT AND OPINION PIECES**

Care must be taken to distinguish between comment and fact, but this can be extremely difficult. In a number of cases IPSO faced the challenge of balancing protection of freedom of expression (and particularly contrarian views) with the rigorous requirements of the Editors' Code in relation to accuracy. The course of the pandemic demonstrated the value of protecting dissent; some views that

were initially considered controversial later came to be widely accepted, and others that were initially mainstream were later discredited. Critical to these decisions was consideration of whether evidence cited in support of the opinion was presented accurately and without distortion.

#### WHITEHEAD V TELEGRAPH.CO.UK

The complainant said that an opinion piece on 'herd immunity' in London was innaccurate, as no natural immunity to Covid-19 would be gained by people who have had a common cold caused by a Coronavirus, as suggested by the article. The Committee ruled that readers would judge the term 'natural immunity' as meaning possessing antibodies protecting against Covid-19, which was not accurate in this circumstance.

# Quality journalism.


Stepping up training and engagement to ensure our regulated publishers remain on journalism's cutting edge

he pandemic has demonstrated the value of accountable news in an unprecedented way. It has given the regulated press an opportunity to show that it is engaged in a different enterprise from social media and other unregulated material.

As the independent regulator of most newspapers and magazines, IPSO plays an important role in supporting high-quality journalism through its training and engagement with regulated publishers.

#### THE IPSO PODCAST

In late 2021, the IPSO podcast was revived after an enforced break due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Featuring twenty-one episodes to date and covering many of the areas of guidance laid out in our resources section, the podcast is a great resource for journalists and members of the public alike. The podcast will undergo further changes in 2022, with a focus on regular content covering anything from IPSO's processes to new guidance.



IPSO partnered with the National Council for the Training of Journalists (NCTJ) to provide an e-learning course on the Journalism Skills Academy (JSA), to helping journalists to understand the regulations which underpin their work. The course guides learners through IPSO's work, key rulings, and the requirements of the Editors' Code of Practice.

IPSO's Journalists' Advisory Panel provides a platform for journalists from all areas of the industry to have a say on IPSO's guidance and training. In 2021 they contributed to drafts of pieces of guidance as well as offering a helpful take on IPSO's strategy.

IPSO also developed its first-ever training newsletter, which is available free to regulated publishers. This newsletter focuses on a different theme each month with appropriate guidance, relevant case studies, and other useful information on the theme.

IPSO has also revamped its online training offering, with guidance covering a range of topics including:

#### **DEATHS AND INQUESTS**

Covering the legal framework for reporting on inquests and general guidelines on sensitivity and Clause 4. Inquests are a particuarly difficult area to report on due to the often sensitive content. This guidance is designed to help reporters get to grips with what the Editors'

Code has to say on sensitivity surrounding death as well as the more detailed legal side of reporting on inquests.

#### **REPORTING OF ISLAM**

Guidance focusing on how the Editors' Code applies to reporting of Muslims and Islam. Released after consultations with members and representatives of the Muslim community in the UK, this guidance is intended to be a reference sheet for journalists with particular regard to Clause 12 (Discrimination) of the Editors' Code and how to take sufficient care when writing articles.

#### **SEXUAL OFFENCES**

The IPSO sexual offences reporting guidance

advises on legal obligations, anonymity, and avoiding unwanted identification. This is a particularly important area of journalism as anonymity and non-identification is essential to protect the privacy of a victim of sexual abuse. Clause 11 of the Editors' Code lays out the care required in reporting on victims of sexual assault.

#### **FURTHER GUIDANCE**

IPSO has produced further guidance on topics including: suicide, due prominence of corrections, court reporting, use of social media, and major incidents guidance, all of which can be found in the resources and guidance section of the website. IPSO will continue to release new guidance in 2022.

# Media literacy.

## Helping the public to identify trusted, accountable news

n the age of 'fake news', media literacy is increasingly important. It is crucial that the public is able to assimilate media, and to understand why certain subjects are covered.

Promoting media literacy amongst the public has always been an aim and value held by IPSO. "Media literacy" has an expansive definition but can simply refer to an individual's ability to access and evaluate media, and to understand why and how subjects are reported.

IPSO plays an important role in promoting media literacy. Each publisher regulated by IPSO - whether in print or online - has committed to upholding the highest professional standards of accuracy and accountability established by the Editors' Code of Practice.

The IPSO Mark is a symbol of that accountability.

#### • WHERE TO FIND THE IPSO MARK



The IPSO mark appears on all IPSO-regulated national news publications in print and online as well as many regional, local, and online-only publications. In print, the mark can be usually be found within the first few pages alongside an explanation of IPSO's functionality. Online, the mark can often be found in the footer of a website or via the complaints page or the 'about us' page


The Mark indicates that content is produced to the high standards required by the Editors' Code and that the publisher has made themselves accountable to an independent regulator.

IPSO produces and regularly updates information sheets on a number of issues for members of the public who may be dealing with the press or first responders or the police for the first time. By keeping the public informed of their rights and the way the press operates, IPSO's guidance can provide a solid platform to build media literacy.

To produce this guidance, IPSO's standards department meets with a variety of external stakeholders, advocacy groups, and charities to ensure that our guidance takes into account all possible views and considers all possible issues.

The standards department met 29 groups in 2021, including representatives from the police, charity workers, local and national editors and journalists, and a variety of other stakeholders.

Our approach to media literacy requires constant monitoring of the media landscape to offer the most up-to-date guidance and advice. IPSO monitors general editorial standards as well as specifically monitoring complaints made under Clause 12 (Discrimination). Both are reported on quarterly. The results of these analyses are used to inform the creation of IPSO guidance which, in turn, provides the building blocks for members of the public and journalists alike to increase their media literacy on a topic.

# Protecting the public through advice, guidance, and robust regulation

ow more than ever, it is critically important for IPSO to fulfill its duty to the public. With public trust in the media under threat and the pandemic requiring reporting of the utmost accuracy, IPSO continues to protect the public by upholding the highest editorial standards.

As a regulator, IPSO serves a trifold purpose:

- To help members of the public who need support.
- To uphold the highest professional standards in the UK press.
- To determine whether standards have been breached and provide redress if so.

Our vision is a trusted, thriving, free and responsible press, reinforced by independent, effective regulation. We cannot achieve any of this without fulfilling our role as supporter of the public

#### INSTANT ACTION

If a request is urgent, the fastest way IPSO can help a member of the public is by issuing a Privacy Notice. These can be requested via our 24 hour emergency hotline on 07799 903 929 and are designed to help those who are experiencing press harassment. To complain about press coverage or a specific article, there is also an online complaints form at www.ipso.co.uk/complain. All complaints are treated equally and assessed by members of our complaints team using the Editors' Code of Practice.

Everything we do is to ensure that editorial standards and public interest are aligned.

# TO HELP THOSE WHO NEED OUR SUPPORT

IPSO has two primary functions to support those who need our assistance. In cases requiring immediate intervention, IPSO can make use of Privacy Notices. These non-binding but widely followed notices can be asked for 24/7 via our emergency press harassment phone line and are designed to prevent unwanted attention from the press, often from individuals not accustomed to press scrutiny.

In 2021, IPSO issued 54 Privacy Notices, just over one a week. Each time a notice is requested, an assessment is done by the officer on-call and, if a notice is considered appropriate, then one is issued immediately to all member publishers. The Editors' Code says that journalists must not continue to question, contact, or photograph people once they have been asked to stop. If you clearly request that a journalist stops their activities, the Editors' Code requires them to do so unless there is specific and adequate public interest to justify a decision to carry on.

The second function that IPSO uses to help those who need our support is our complaints process, overseen by our Head of Complaints and Pre-Publication Services, Rob Morrison. IPSO receives thousands of complaints a year with every single

complaint receiving an assessment by a member of staff. IPSO takes all complaints seriously and wherever possible will always attempt mediation between the complainant and the publication to try to reach a speedy and satisfactory resolution. Failing that, our complaints officers will investigate thoroughly and the Complaints Committee will make a ruling at the conclusion of the investigation.

# TO UPHOLD THE HIGHEST PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN THE UK PRESS

IPSO took a proactive approach to upholding the highest professional standards in the UK press in 2021. The Standards & Communications teams met with 29 separate organisations to hear their thoughts on guidance and the Editors' Code. These conversations inform later collation of information into our official guidance that IPSO releases semiregularly on a number of topics. Though no new guidance was issued in 2021, enough evidence was collected for the production of three new guidance

documents to be released in 2022.

IPSO also began to publish a new monthly training newsletter and increased training provision following the recruitment of Jane Debois, Head of Standards and Regulation, who has expanded her department and the services it provides..

# TO DETERMINE IF STANDARDS HAVE BEEN BREACHED AND PROVIDE REDRESS

IPSO continues to monitor all complaints and uses this information to address any standards issues directly. Trends were closely monitored on selected news topics including complaints made under Clause 12 (Discrimination).

All complaints about Covid-19 or involving Covid-19 were kept under surveillance in case IPSO had to intervene with any particular publication's coverage of the pandemic. This was an especially important function in the context of a global emergency.

# Case studies.

Seven examples of the IPSO complaints process in action

James v Mail Online

Adjudication required following upheld privacy and harassment complaint

LILY JAMES complained about a number of Mail Online articles which reported on various aspects of the complainant's life, including her personal and social life and her work commitments. Photographs accompanied some of the articles showing the complainant seated at a table inside a restaurant. The publication also instructed a journalist to look for the complainant in the vicinity of her home. She complained under Clause 2 (Privacy) and Clause 3 (Harassment) of the Code.

Prior to the complaint, the complainant contacted IPSO on three separate occasions with concerns about press harassment. On each occasion a Privacy Notice was issued by IPSO to remind the press of its obligations under the Editors' Code, with particular regard to Clause 2 and Clause 3 of the Code. The

complainant's representatives had also contacted the publication.

The Committee ruled that the high number of articles did not represent a breach of Clause 3 of the Code by themselves. However, there was a breach of Clause 3 over the journalist instructed to look for the complainant as these instructions had come after the third Privacy Notice had been issued and there was not enough evidence of fresh developments in the story to justify this disregard of a clear request to desist. As the complainant had taken steps to increase the privacy of her surroundings, the Committee found an additional breach of Clause 2 over the publication of photographs in the restaurant.

# **Brewerton v Various**

Complaints against a number of publications over coverage of 'Jackie Weaver' Zoom meeting not upheld.

THE COMPLAINANTS were a parish councillor and his father featured in a viral Zoom meeting which received national press coverage owing to an argument between the complainants and a clerk.

The complainants said there were multiple inaccuracies in the articles, and also claimed breaches of Clauses 2, 3, 4, and 10 of the Editors' Code. They alleged that a journalist from one publication had violated their privacy by sending a message on social media, and that a journalist from another publication had called at the house posing as a roofer and not produced credentials when asked.

The Committee noted that social media contact from journalists does not necessarily constitute harassment - in this case it was a single message in which the journalist identified himself and the publication he worked for.

The publication denied that their journalist had approached the complainant pretending to be a roofer. The complainant was unable to confirm the time of day of the approach, so the Committee could not rule on this factual dispute.

The alleged inaccuracies, including that the 'clerk' was not a clerk, were based on a contested reading of the minutes of the meeting. The complainants said these minutes were inaccurate, but as the official record of the meeting, publications were entitled to rely on these as record.

# Nelson v Sunday Life

Complaint partially upheld over use of sources in article concerning Rathcoole riots.

THE PUBLICATION reported on a riot in Rathcoole, Northern Ireland, in an article containing photographs of alleged participants in the riot wearing balaclavas.

The complaint under Clause 1 was from an individual identified in the article who denied he was present at the riot and that he had told the newspaper that this was the case prior to publication. The newspaper responded that it had two confidential sources who had corroborated his appearance at the riot but would publish his denial in response to his initial

complaint and correct the article accordingly. The Committee ruled that the newspaper refusing to disclose its confidential sources did not absolve the publication of its requirement to take care over the accuracy of information included in its articles. In this case, the publication had not taken any further steps to verify the information provided by the sources and had consequently published uncorroborated photographs of individuals whose faces were obscured.

# Evison v Yorkshirepost.co.uk

Complaint not upheld after conflicting family permissions given concerning publication of details of a deceased man's mental health.

THE PUBLICATION reported on the death of a North Yorkshire sheep farmer after a press release from a mental health charity named him as a victim of suicide.

The article contained quotes from the man's partner and claimed he had been struggling with depression.

The complaint was the mother of the man who died. She said the article was inaccurate and that her son did not die by suicide, citing the ongoing investigation into the cause of death and that an inquest had yet to be held. She also said it was

inaccurate to claim that her son had "struggled" with depression. Whilst she accepted that he had been diagnosed with depression a short time before his death, this did not constitute a struggle.

The Committee ruled that appropriate care had been taken when writing the article and that there was no breach of the Code. The publication had sought and received permission from the man's partner and not breached the terms of Clause 5 by going into excessive detail.

# A man and a woman v Ardrossan & Saltcoats Herald

No breach of Code over information inferred from visible clothing in report on charity bike ride.

THE PUBLICATION reported on a charity cycle ride by a large group of people in aid of a cancer charity.

The complainants were a woman mentioned in the article as being a "breast cancer survivor" and her husband, who had also been mentioned in the article. They said that the article breached Clause 2 because it disclosed her medical condition without her consent.

The Committee ruled that the information was

personal but also in the public domain. The complainant was wearing a pink t-shirt referencing her successful recovery from cancer on the bike ride and her public social media page contained posts promoting the cycle ride with other references to breast cancer. The information was, therefore, considered to be publicly available by the Complaints Committee.

# IPSO v Tatler

Clause 16 (Payment to criminals) not engaged in Tatler article concerning partygoers during the Covid-19 lockdown.

ON THE recommendation of the Board of IPSO the Complaints Committee launched an own-volition inquiry into whether Tatler had breached Clause 16 (Payment to criminals) of the Editors' Code. The article in question was a series of extracts from the diary of an anonymous partygoer, detailing their experiences in breaking the Covid-19 lockdown.

The action was taken by the IPSO Board after questions arose over the payment made to the author of the article, as lockdown parties were technically against the law and therefore any payment could be in breach of Clause 16 (Payment to criminals) which prevents journalists from paying confessed criminals in exchange for stories

that glamourise or exploit crime unless there is a legitimate public interest demonstrated.

The Committee found that the publication had made a payment of £400 to the anonymous author, but that this payment was not in breach of the Code as the author had not actually broken the law and was not a confessed criminal. The unique status of Covid-19 legislation meant that, even if a member of the public was issued with a fixed penalty notice, this was not technically a criminal offence and would therefore not result in a criminal conviction so the terms of Clause 16 were not engaged.

# Various v express.co.uk

Complaints upheld over reporting of farmer's comments on staff shortages and their alleged attribution to Brexit.

THE PUBLICATION published an article headline, "Farmer blasts EU red tape stopping workers flow to UK - fears shops will use Europe goods"

IPSO received 199 complaints about this article, all of which raised similar concerns. The complainants said the headline was inaccurate and misleading as the farmer mentioned did not attribute his loss of earnings to "EU red tape" but rather the UK government's changes to immigration policy post-Brexit. The newspaper amended the article after

receiving notification of the IPSO investigation, changing the headline and content of the article to reflect that the "EU red tape" was actually the result of Brexit negotiations.

The Committee ruled that the initial headline was misleading and upheld the complaints under Clause 1 (Accuracy). The newspaper was not required to make a further correction.


# Most complained about publications 2021

Newspapers with the highest circulation, digital reach and readership numbers receive the most complaints, but have the lowest proportion of breaches

THE PUBLICATIONS in this list are ranked by number of articles complained about. Unsurprisingly, the publications with the highest circulation and readerships received the most complaints. Interestingly though, considering the large amount of content produced by these newspapers on a daily basis, the number of articles complained about are comparatively low.

Where complaints are listed as rejected, they did not raise a possible breach of the Editors' Code. Some of the publications received many complaints, but were not in breach. An increase in the proportion of complaints resolved between publication and complainant during the referral period demonstrates how this process encourages quick resolution of complaints.

# Editorial standards monitoring

# Gathering and analysing evidence on editorial standards

IPSO has a broad commitment to press standards beyond complaints handling. Led by IPSO's standards function, we use knowledge and data from daily work with complaints, wide monitoring of the media landscape and engagement with groups interested in coverage of particular issues to track patterns and identify areas of potential concern to provide targeted interventions.

IPSO's standards function took action against a regulated publisher after a pattern of upheld complaints was detected during monitoring. The Jewish Chronicle was placed under 6 month review and assigned mandatory training with the aim of improving editorial standards. The situation is being closely monitored and improvement has already been noted.

# **Arbitration**

## Low-cost, fast, and equal resolutions to disputes

Arbitration is a process in which two parties resolve legal disputes without going to court. People who feel they have been wronged by a newspaper can use the arbitration scheme to lay claims against a newspaper efficiently, effectively and cheaply.

IPSO began a voluntary arbitration scheme in 2016. In 2018, IPSO made arbitration compulsory for national newspapers, meaning anyone with a valid

claim against an IPSO-regulated national newspaper could seek to resolve their dispute through the IPSO arbitration scheme. The compulsory scheme has been operational for two years.

IPSO will continue to promote the uptake of the arbitration service and communicate the advantages of this efficient and cost-effective means of taking legal complaints against the press.


